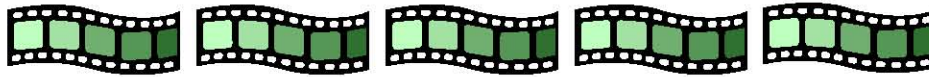
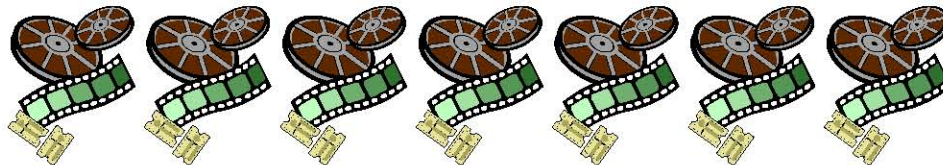


## SENATE BILL 23 - HOUSE BILL 67
